Building and using a Keyhole Garden is an excellent team building project for children and adults.

A Keyhole Garden is a sustainable way to grow your own food in a very small area. It is a raised circular garden bed that recycles and composts while it is growing.

A pie shaped wedge (the keyhole) allows access to the central basket.
To begin create the garden bed with cement blocks or other available materials. Fill the structure with cardboard, newspaper, and greens in a 3:1 ratio
